Kids' Writes **2012** *Directed by Cara MacPhail*

Now in its 30th season, *Kids' Writes* is the popular show that involves elementary school students and an ensemble of young VYT actors in a writing-acting collaboration. Without changing a word of the original, stories and poems are dramatized in simple, story-theatre style using costume pieces, props, masks, and sound effects.

This program includes a tour of local Elementary schools and festivals and the actor will be required to miss approx. 5 days of school in April & May.

This advanced program requires an audition or permission of the Director.

Teen Ensemble **"Why Justice" on tour!** *Directed by Heather Duff* *with Musical Directors Glenn Chatten & Ross Fairbairn*

The Teen ensemble (ages 13+) will explore topics related to youth and youth leadership in the arts and social justice. Actors will work collaboratively to create a play based on their ideas.

This program will include a tour of local Secondary schools and the actors will be required to miss approximately 5 days of school in April & May (not consecutive days).

Fee: \$490 Total + membership (if not paid)
